Information on Curling Fees and Application

- The membership application identifies the total of all fees that are due based on the number of rounds you will curl. These fees include the following: a) an ice rental amount, which has increased due to higher operating costs; b) a building development fee of \$25 to cover upgrades to equipment and renovations required in future years with a reduction to \$15 for those who only curl for one round (no change from last year); c) a \$10 food voucher redeemable for food and coffee at the Club; and d) a Curl Manitoba fee of \$10 (no change from previous years).
- Spares must register but **pay their fees** at the end of each round at \$8 per game for the number of games played during that round.
- The Social Fee of \$10 applies only to those **who are not curling/sparing** but wish to retain seniority and receive information on events, such as meetings and luncheons which they can attend.

Please note the following:

- 1. If you register to play as a regular curler in more than one league at the Pembina Curling Club you are required to pay the Building Development fee, the Food Voucher fee, and the Curl Manitoba fee to each league. However, these fees are payable only once so if you paid these fees to more than one league, you are eligible for a refund for amounts paid more than once. Details on how to claim your refund if you curl in more than one league will be provided after league play begins.
- 2. Registration requires the submission of two signed forms in addition to the application. One is the Waiver and Release from Liability and a copy of this is attached. The second is a Declaration of Compliance COVID-19 form. The form used last year is attached for information but there may be changes in the form as the COVID protocols to be followed by the Pembina Curling Club will be consistent with provincial policies and guidelines.
- 3. Please answer all questions that apply to you on the application form and return your application using one of the options noted at the bottom of the registration form. Please include a signed copy of the PCC Waiver and Release from Liability form with your application. You may wish to wait on the COVID-19 Declaration form until you hear from us about whether the current form will be revised.
- **4.** The **in-person registration date is September 7th between 1:00 and 2:30 PM** at the Pembina Curling Club. Other options for registration are noted on the Registration Form.
- 5. The tentative dates for the four rounds of league play are: Round 1- October 3 to November 7; Round 2-November 9 to December 19; Round 3 December 21 to February 1; Round 4 February 3 to March 10. The Last Chance Bonspiel dates are March 13 to 24.
- **6.** The 2022-23 semi-annual meeting of our league is scheduled for September 27th between 1:00 and 2:30 PM at the Pembina Curling Club.
